## **Rules and Regulations**

Discussion: We have been charged with creating rules and regulations applicable to our Department, separate from the medical staff bylaws and covering areas not addressed by them. Looking back through our available archives and information, there is not an existing body of information to update, so we may begin this process with a fresh slate.

For this project, I have begun identifying a proposed set up topics to include in out Department Rules and Regulations. As you can see from the selection, some of these may codify what we are doing currently, and some subjects are important to discuss so we can set standards that currently may not exist. In such cases we would encourage discussion and participation of all members we can engage so there is ample opportunity to look at all aspects of what we establish before we incorporate it into what we do.

Potential subjects to be covered:

- 1. Committees and Department organization
- 2. Board certification initial application, reappointment
- 3. Criteria for specific privileges initial and reappointment
- 4. Meeting attendance
- 5. On call and coverage requirements
- 6. Commitment to and definition of value based care
- 7. Resource utilization
- 8. Care transition inpatient physicians, subspecialty physicians, outpatient physicians
- 9. Appropriate utilization of non-physician providers
- 10. Criteria for recredentialling and OPPE hospitalists, NPP's, subspecialists, dualists, ambulatoryonly
- 11. Medical records timeliness and quality
- 12. Knowledge and education including CME
- 13. Participation in departmental activities meetings, electronic communications, other
- 14. FPPE
- 15. Standards of EHR proficiency, usage, data exchange
- 16. Mortality review process
