RE: The Reemergence of Ambulatory Testing/Procedures

Catholic Health will begin to restore non-emergent ambulatory test, including screening exams. In an effort to ensure the safety of our patients and associates the following guidelines have been put in place:

- Patients and providers will now be able to schedules exams
- Walk-in patients will be asked to return to their cars to wait until for the next opening. This will allow for us to manage the walk-in patients with scheduled patients to support proper social distancing requirements. We would encourage all providers to schedule when possible
- All patients will be health screened at the time of scheduling, and again upon arrival to the facility
- All patients and employees will be required to don a mask throughout the patient visit
- Pulmonary Function testing will require a COVID test three days prior to the exam date, similar to the process used for elective surgeries
- Interventional radiology procedures will follow the same process as PFT and elective surgeries as required by the NYSDOH
- Pain management will be treated in the same manner as other imaging tests. No COVID test required
- SOC St. Josephs Campus will be receiving COVID positive patients only
