


New Diagnosis Hard-stop

Per new regulations, and documentation requirements, you will see a new “hard-stop” when certain diagnosis are added to your patient’s chart. For example, when adding Asthma you will now be asked to add additional details before you may continue – see the below – notice the red hard-stop icon
