- Cardioversion orders – new prompt for anticoagulation therapy**

In order to prevent clinicians from ending the cardioversion log and “starting over” in the TEE with Possible Cardioversion log, we have added a question for anticoagulation.

- New NPO question added to TEE orders**

An additional question has been added to the Inpatient TEE order to help avoid rescheduling the procedure: Has the patient been NPO for 8 hours?

- Religious and Cultural considerations**

Assessment of Religious and Cultural considerations is required at the time of admission and on an ongoing basis as needed during the patient’s hospitalization. (effective Oct 29)
